*Arrival, shopping and buggy ride times are flexible. Dinner seating times are requested to start no earlier than 4:00pm & no later than 6:00pm.

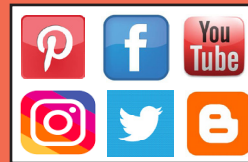


TERMS & CONDITIONS:
